### **Be Firewise & Burn Safely**

Please call AQMD at 1-866-287-6329 for burn day information for Shelter Cove (Zone 1).

Burning is only allowed on authorized Air Quality Management District (AQMD) burn days with a valid AQMD burn permit on-site. Permits run from January to December and can be obtained online from <http://www.ncuaqmd.org/>.

Before burning cleared vegetation, please obtain the proper burn permits. Be a good neighbor and let smoke sensitive neighbors know that you will be burning. Let's all make a big effort to engage with friends and neighbors and help each other to mitigate fire hazards.

Please document your activity on a Firewise Volunteer Hourly Worksheet Form so it can go towards Shelter Cove getting re-certified as a Firewise Community in 2022. A copy of the form is available at the office and on our website under the Fire Department page.

The cost (fee) of using this service is 2.25% per (self-pay) transaction. Visa, Mastercard, American Express and Discover Card credit and debit cards are accepted.
