NEW FIRE TRUCK ARRIVES

Out with the old in with the new! Your Resort Improvement District and Shelter Cove Fire is excited to announce with support from our amazing community and the RID Board of Directors that we have replaced all of our outdated fire engines.

For the first time in its history, Shelter Cove will be protected by a modern fleet of firefighting equipment staffed by 20 firefighters. Our new fleet includes a 2014 Ram 4x4 ambulance (5171), 2018 Ram Command 4x4 (5100), 2019 Ram rescue/ Duty Officers truck (5147), 2009/2020 Rosenbauer



Wildland Urban Interface 4x4 engine (5116), and a 2021 Rosenbauer 4x4 tactical water tender (5166).

With over one million dollars in new firefighting equipment purchased in the last 4 years, the District is committed to providing the best possible fire and rescue services to the community of Shelter Cove. Even with all this new equipment we still need the community to do its part.

Please create and maintain defensible space around your home and property, and make sure your address is easily seen from the street in both directions. You can obtain a street number sign for free by contacting Susie CERT at foxdenorth@gmail.com or by visiting the Shelter Cove Farmer's Market on each Tuesday in October.

Shelter Cove CERT has already provided over 100 free street signs to residences in the community.

FIRE SEASON CONTINUES!

Please call 911 immediately if you see or suspect a wildfire. October and November are part of our active wildfire season on the Northcoast. Please wait for the official announcement from Cal Fire before starting to burn any vegetation piles. The District's community chipper program will run through the end of October.
