USDA GRANT AWARDED

Your Resort Improvement District has been notified that it will receive **\$6.2 million** in community wildfire defense grant funding to conduct 1,211 acres of hazardous fuels reduction work over a 5-year period. This project is designed to protect life and property in Shelter Cove, reduce wildfire risk, create a fire resilient community, and restore healthy landscapes. ANNUAL RECYCLED WATER NOTICE

Shortly, night-time irrigation of the golf links will resume using recycled water from our wastewater treatment plant. Irrigation sprinklers are not usually activated until after dark, but people should avoid areas that are actively being sprinkled. This water is safe for irrigation, but not for drinking.
