BURN RESTRICTION LIFTED

CalFire has lifted the burn suspension, but the fire season designation is still in effect. A valid Air Quality Management District burn permit is always required for burning. At the present time, CalFire ALSO requires that you obtain an additional CalFire burn permit. You can apply online at: https://burnpermit.fire.ca.gov

Annual AQMD permits run from January to December, take a week to process and are available at the Fire Station/District office. Completed applications and the residential burn permit fee must be sent to the AQMD office at 707 L Street, Eureka, CA 95501. For a quicker turnaround you may apply online: http://www.ncuaqmd.org/index.php?page = burn.permits . Your permit will be emailed to you.

Burn day information for Shelter Cove (Zone 1) is available each day by calling 1-866-BURN-DAY. Please have your permit on-site while burning.

Defensible Space Around Your Home:

Even though we have received a bit of rain, Shelter Cove may still experience intermittent dry conditions. Please make an effort to clear away all flammable materials from within 30ft of your home. This includes highly flammable vegetation and landscaping materials, firewood, construction materials, leaves and needles in gutters and fuels such as gasoline tanks. Mow lawns regularly and limb trees up 6 to 10ft from the ground. Create a "fire-free" area within 5ft of the home, using non-combustible landscaping materials like crushed stone and gravel.

Please log your hours worked clearing, piling, and burning vegetation, and money spent hardening your home to wildfire by using a **Firewise Volunteer Hourly Work Sheet**. You will find a form in this mailing, and on the District's website Fire Department Page https://sheltercove-ca.gov/fire-dept/firewise/. Bring the completed form to the District office as soon as possible for inclusion in our Firewise recertification in November. This information will greatly help to maintain Shelter Cove's status as a Firewise Community for the 2023 season.

During the pacific winter weather cycle, large ocean swells generated from southerly storms impact Shelter Cove's shoreline. People should exercise caution when high surf conditions are present. Never turn your back on the ocean. Stay further back from the water than usual, stay off the jetty and rocks as sleeper waves and strong riptides appear along the coastline.
