## **BE READY FOR WINTER DRIVING**

Be prepared for winter driving conditions! Carry food, water, and blankets in your vehicle. If there are road conditions/culverts in need of repair in your neighborhood, please direct your calls to Humboldt County Roads 707-445-7421 so the repair request can be logged. Early reporting can stop damage from becoming more serious.

## FIRE EXTINGUISHER RECHARGE REMINDER

The community may bring their fire extinguishers to the Fire House on the morning of Wednesday, December 13<sup>th</sup>, for recharging by Eureka-Humboldt Fire Extinguisher, phone 822-2517. The cost of this service will depend on the unit size.

#### **CEASE THE GREASE**

With Holidays gatherings and shared meals, please remember that pouring fats, oils, and grease (FOG) down kitchen drains accumulates inside sewer pipes. As the "FOG" builds up it restricts the flow in the pipe and can cause untreated wastewater to back up into homes and businesses! This results in high costs for cleanup and restoration of the sewer system and private septic systems. It's NO fun! Don't dump FOG down your sink!
