Shelter Cove Loop Incident 6/24

The Shelter Cove Wildfire Resiliency and Community Defense Project is happening now! It is funded by the U.S. Forest Service, Department of Agriculture, Wildfire Defense Grant with project coordination provided by the Trees Foundation.

During the first phase, trained technicians (who are also local volunteer firefighters with knowledge of fire behavior) will be conducting home risk assessments on all homes within the Shelter Cove community. These assessments are intended to inform residents on how to strategize their efforts to protect their homes from wildfire. This visit will also be used to assess and coordinate **FREE** fuel reduction work by qualified contractors for every Shelter Cove property!

BURNING SUSPENDED

CAL FIRE has announced the suspension of all burn permits for outdoor residential burning within the State Responsibility Area of Humboldt and Del Norte Counties. This suspension took effect on **July 1st, 2024**, and applies to all residential outdoor burning of landscape debris such as branches and leaves.

DISTRICT BOARD ELECTIONS REMINDER

Special District Elections will be held on Tuesday, November 5th, 2024. There are **three (3) four-year term positions** available on the Resort Improvement District Board. Candidates must be registered voters within Shelter Cove. The filing period commences **July 15th and runs through August 9th, 2024**. If an incumbent does not file by 5 pm on August 9th there is a five-day extension for anyone other than the incumbent to file. Filing is free. **Completion of forms must be done at the Humboldt County Office of Elections** located at 2426 6th Street, Eureka, CA 95501-0788. The process takes approximately 30 minutes to complete. Optional Candidate Statements must be paid for by the candidate. THE SOLAR QUESTION



Stand-alone **solar systems are permitted** in Shelter Cove. However, the Resort Improvement District's interconnection agreement for wholesale power transmission with PG&E and RID's ordinances currently prohibit the **interconnection** of home/rooftop solar installations with RID's electrical system. This solar interconnection prohibition is necessary to protect PG&E & RID electrical infrastructure and RID electrical staff. Home/rooftop solar installations must be isolated from RID's electrical system. **Prior RID approval is required** for the installation of **any alternate energy source** and must include a method of positive disconnect. The customer's equipment must be capable of transferring load between the two systems in an open transition or non-parallel mode. There must be either an electrically or mechanically interlocking switching arrangement, which precludes operation of both switches in the closed position.

Failure to comply with District guidelines will result in the customer being held liable for any subsequent damage or injury. If an unauthorized grid tied system is discovered by RID staff, they have the right to **immediately disconnect** RID electric service.
